Mission

Contribute to establishing a climate of peace in Haiti by working with emotional wellbeing and mental health of the Haitian population in general and vulnerable groups in particular (women, children, disabled communities, families, schools. ..)

Objectives

The main objectives of the Foundation are:

1. To contribute concretely to a change of mentality and thus to the establishment of a climate of peace in Haiti
2. Participate in a recovery of values of the Haitian society and promotion of such values: tolerance, inclusion, non-discrimination and love
3. Provide to citizens and youth especially, a continuing education program for accessing principles of success and to inspire them a desire to remain and / or return to Haiti
4. Provide a protective framework for particularly vulnerable populations (women, children, disabled) as well as awareness and prevention programs to combat and eliminate social, marital and family violence
5. Promote access to programs and mental health care by providing free psychological services and / or moderate cost.

Activities of the Foundation cover two main axes:

- Axis 1 Development of Psychological Resources
- Axis 2 Personnel and Organizational Development

Axis Development of Psychological Resources

Mission

The Axis of Psychological Resources Development of the Foundation (FOI), through its work with disadvantaged populations and the most vulnerable groups (women, children, disabled) and victims of trauma, has as Mission to promote:

- Access to a large number of psychological services (individual and group)
- Development of professional mental health through education and research
- Reduction of violence in families, schools and the Haitian community
- Establishment of a climate of peace in Haiti.

Credo

At the Axis of Psychological Resources Development, we believe that working with LOVE, JOY and RIGOR, we contribute to a climate of PEACE, JUSTICE and HARMONY in the Haitian Community.

Target audience

The Foundation (FOI) is open to work with all sectors of the population: Industry, Commerce, national and international organizations, public, private and mixed Institutions, Educational Institutions, Schools, non-profit associations ... and particularly with vulnerable groups (women, children, disabled, families...)

Assets (activities already carried out)

Education for Peace program in Haiti

From December 2011 to April 2015 the following activities were carried out by the Foundation:

Promotion Project of Mental Health and a Peace climate in Haiti

1. Training

- 39 Mental Health Professionals (Juniors and Seniors) trained in:
 - Counseling with patients
 - Stabilization techniques and the standard protocol for EMDR
 - Diagnostic of patients pathology
 - Understanding the personal dynamics of their customers through the Transactional Analysis model
 - Personal development through these experiences

- 28 mental health professionals trained to respond to acute stress to constitute an emergency unit in case of possible disasters
- 4 Professional supervisors have received 26 hours of supervision with trainers Trauma AID
- 26 mental health professionals trained in systemic family therapy and empowered to intervene with families in difficulty
- 8 professional from FOI trained to work in schools
- 4 Professional certified and validated as Facilitators
- 39 professionals trained to provide support and screen people with psychological disorders and capable to coach and screen people with psychological disorders
- 648 principals and teachers from 14 schools and orphanage (Port-au-Prince and Provinces) trained to establish a climate of peace in schools.

2. Support in individual therapy, family and group therapy, ritual of mourning

- Individual Therapies

1315 Sessions conducted

470 People - 99 men / 178 women / 138 children

- Group therapies:

109 sessions conducted

365 People

Total number of sessions: 1424

Total number of patients: 835

- 370 people affected by disasters (natural and accident / assault rape) are currently being processed and are followed by psychotherapists free of charge
- realized Mourning Rituals
- Functional Emergency Unit.

3. Prevention Programs

- 648 directors and teachers from 14 schools trained in establishing a climate of peace in schools and Haitian families
- 648 directors and teachers from 14 schools, 622 parents 17 communities of Port-au-Prince and its suburbs and province related to those schools affected by the campaign against violence on children
- 20 conferences of two hours each with about 1000 Parents and Educators across the Republic (Port-au-Prince / Mirebalais / Saut d'Eau / Gonaïves / Dessalines / Fonds Parisien / Cap Haitien / Jean-Rabel / Ouanaminthe / Jacmel / Miragoane / Aquinas / Jeremiah)
- 500 CDs in Creole distributed through schools in Port-au-Prince and 9 cities Emission TV / radio
