Project «Psychological Assistance»

Context

Since 2012, the Foundation has established an Emergency Unit with about thirty (30) psychologists trained and specialized in psycho trauma. These professionals of Mental Health offer free psychosocial services to the Haitian population, if necessary, through a program designed by the Axis Development of Psychological Resources of the Foundation.

Since the earthquake of January 12, 2010 that devastated the capital of Haiti, (Port-au-Prince and other cities) and killed more than 300,000 people, the Haitian population is aware of the importance of the role played by professional of Mental Health and research increasingly specialized services of these professionals.

We know that the population suffers from many decades of natural and manmade disasters: political unrest, insecurity, family and educational violence, sexual abuse ... These situations leave traces undeniable, and the healing of the emotional wounds requires psychological care in the short, medium and long terms.

Again, Haiti faced a natural disaster; Hurricane Matthew is hitting South-East, South, Grande Anse, North West Departments making a thousand dead and over 200,000 homeless. The Axis Psychological Resource Development proposes for the period from November 01, 2016 to April 30, 2017, the project " Psychological Assistance" for the affected families.

During this phase of 6 months, the focus will be on psychological support under the format of group therapy and / or individual and / or family therapy.

Goal of the project

Help the people of the Departments raised heal his emotional trauma taken through psychological burden especially for vulnerable groups (women. Children and adolescents with disabilities for both genders).

Specific Objectives

Psychological care - Group therapy and / or family and / or individual therapy

- Provide support for those traumatized by Matthew hurricane and other natural disasters
- Provide specialized care for people with psychological disorders (women. children and adolescents with disabilities for both genders) through individual interventions and / or group interventions
- Provide psychological support to people suffering from acute stress and complex trauma

Expected results

Psychological care - Group therapy and / or family and / or individual therapy

- 160 sessions (approximately 800 people (women / children / youth / disabled - both genders) in concerned Departments and their relatives in Port-au-Prince, receive individual therapy sessions and / or group therapy session, using established protocols
- Anyone in emotional difficulty can benefit, if it solicits the services of the Emergency Unit

Outcome Indicators

- Number of therapy sessions (individual, family or group)

- Loyalty in the implementation of protocols
- Number of patients with a mental health condition improved after therapy sessions

Direct beneficiaries

- Children (especially orphans, children living or working on the streets)
- Women
- Most vulnerable and needy
- Disabled (s)
- Persons who have suffered severe trauma
